

Hints and tips: Resetting your WIFI camera – Beta v.2

If you would like to reset your WIFI camera back to factory settings, this tutorial shows you how. The easiest way is on a PC with PC software. See PC option. But if you don't have this, we show you how to do this on a Mac, tablet or phone below this.

PC option

First, take your camera, plug it into the mains and then plug the long connector into a LAN cable (network cable). This should be a straight through cable or normal network cable. Sometimes these come with your router or powerline/homeplugs. Plug the other end of this cable directly into your router.

1. Download software

If you have a PC then download the software from our server. Click here for software:

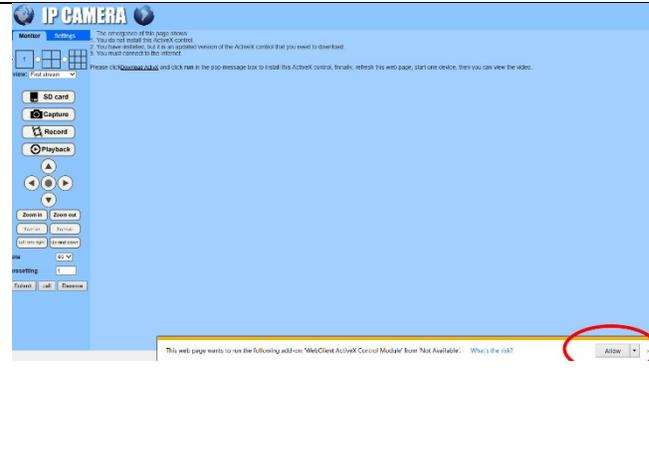

2. Unzip software
3. Run the software. If you can't find it. Look for 'Searchtool' on your PC.

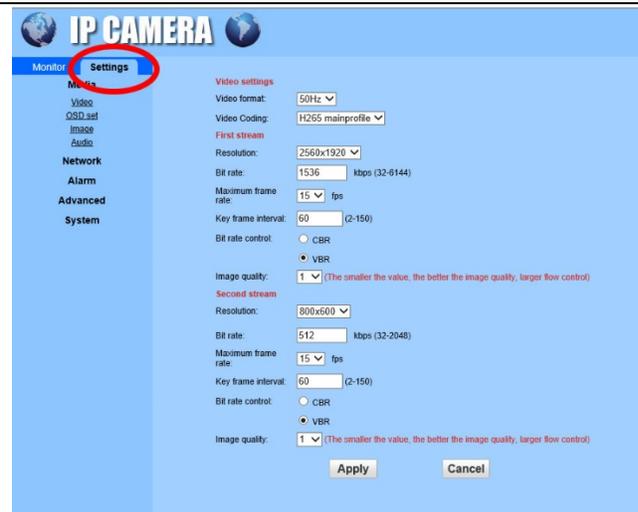
4. You will see the software load. Click on Next button.



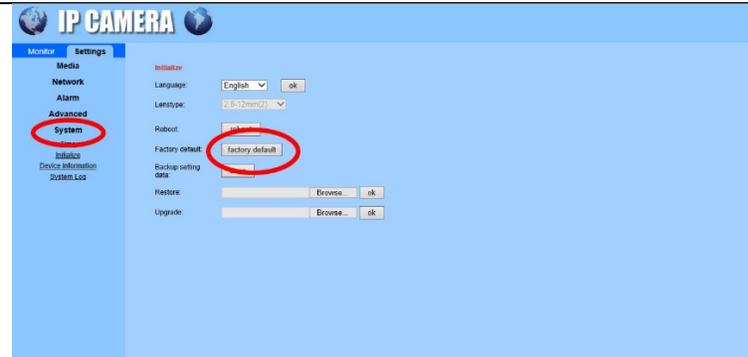
8. You should see the main control panel. Click on 'Allow' at the bottom to allow ActiveX. If you have another browser, don't worry. This will just allow you to see the LIVE view, but it is not really needed.



9. Click 'Settings' tab.



10. Click on 'System' then 'Factory default' button. As soon as you click it, please unplug the lan cable. If you don't, you may have to repeat the process again.



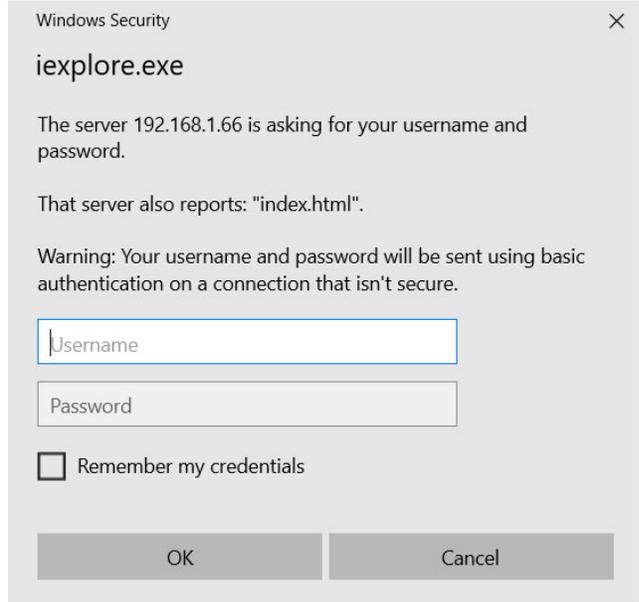
Leave the camera for a few minutes. Use your mobile and then log onto the cameras

WIFI as per the camera instructions.

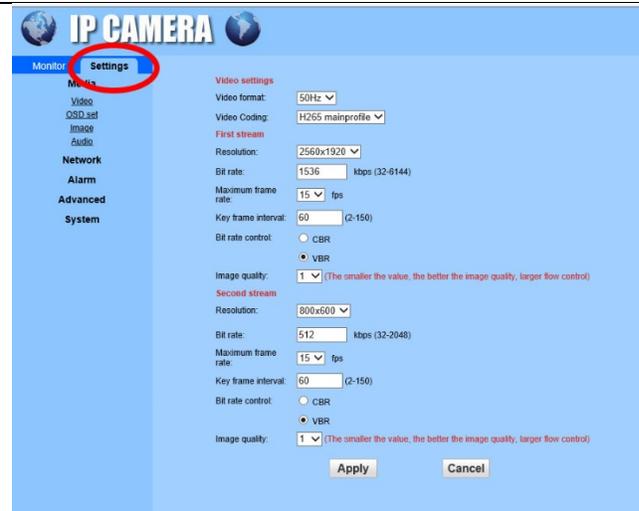
MAC or tablet option

If you don't have access to a PC then you need to follow the following steps. As before, just make sure there is power to the camera and it is plugged directly to your router with a LAN cable:

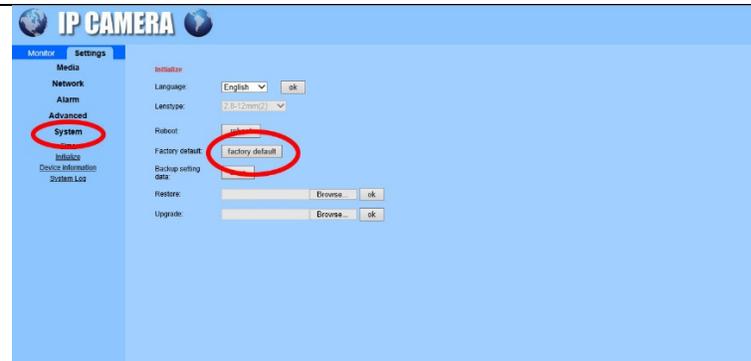
- 1) Log into your router by typing the IP address of your router into your browser. Make sure the device is connected either by a cable or wirelessly to the same router. If you don't know the IP address, just have a look on the bottom of the router (or pull out tab) or the instructions.
- 2) Go to the connected devices on the router. Each router is different, so just look around. It should list all the devices connected to the router.

<p>3) Your default browser should open and you should see a password box appear. Enter 'admin' for username and 'admin' for password.</p>	
<p>4. You should see the welcome screen. Click 'Pc view'.</p>	

5. Click 'Settings' tab.



6. Click on 'System' then 'Factory default' button. As soon as you click it, please unplug the lan cable. If you don't, you may have to repeat the process again.



Leave the camera for a few minutes. Use your mobile and then log onto the cameras WIFI as per the camera instructions.
